Champion Racing Lays Introduction Feb 16th 2011



Review Manager David -Introduces Champion Racing Lays

Hi Bloggers

Review Manager Dave here time to get my hands dirty on LTO my first review on this site will be *Champion Racing Lays 2*, the original version was tested between July/September 2010 on Betting System Truths and failed miserably losing 31.80 points. So why are we reviewing the updated version? Because one of the issues raised by Sergeant Tommy the reviewer then was that the maximum lay of 20.00 was way too high especially for a 50 point bank this has been rectified in the new version. So in the new Champion Racing Lays the maximum odds have been set to 10.00 it concentrates on handicap races on the flat and jumps so you should have all year action. Software is available this time as well as e-mail selections I am using both, the software was easy to set up it gives you options for odds ranges, stakes etc but I have left the default settings in place, so far the e-mails have arrived before 8am UK time so plenty of time to get your bets on just open up the bot and press start, if your internet is unreliable then you could use [Betfair](#) and set up the lay stating a maximum odds limit of 10.00.

Since the new version started on September 1st 2010 to date it has made 20.90 points this is as per the figures shown on the website, it had 161 selections with 131 winning lays this equates to 81.37% strike rate. Average odds of the selections was 5.54 and for losing lays 4.55, it must be admitted that 2011 is showing a small loss of 0.61 points and has not reached the levels of 2010. Now currently Champion Racing Lays are doing a free 14 day trial and then after this it will cost you 53

pounds per month and that includes the software, support etc. Anyway lets see what the review brings and whether the changes and improvements pay of for this service. Just a word of note the vendor still recommends a 50 point starting bank so that is what I shall be using and staking 1 point per selection, all odds stated will be to BFSP.
