
Introduction

The offers can be done at any time of day and normally do not take much of your time. As soon as a subscriber needs another offer he simply sends the request to Mike and gets it. There's a variety of offers available, some are completely risk-free, others are low risk, and the subscribers can choose whatever suits them best.

The Bonus Bagging service is low risk and does not require a large betting bank. The minimum requirement is £150, although I will be using a bank of £200. The actual stakes will vary from offer to offer, depending on terms and conditions.

Mike claims that he uses this method himself and the results can be seen on his blog on the site.

The review of Bonus Bagging is going to last 12 betting weeks with a post for each week.
