A bit of a trick question there you should never need to make a profit.

Wanting to and needing to are two completely separate things so make sure you get that right first.

So realistically how much should you be aiming to achieve?

Well again there's no conclusive answer as everyone one operates in different ways.

Quite recently I've noticed people pushing micro systems, now for those that don't know, micro systems are simple systems that produce just a small number of selections. They can produce as little as one selection a week or month and their profits are generally smaller but possibly steadier.

Now these may only produce 10 points profit a year but if your equipped with 10 of these then you could be producing a 100+ points a year which is a healthy return.

What about subscriptions services?

Some people suggest not to bother with them but I think they have their place.

Major League Profits – Introduction

Inspector Lucian-Introduces Major League Profits

Hi Bloggers,

Today I am introducing, *Major League Profits* an American Football selection service provided by Carlos.

<u>Major League Profits</u> <u>football betting</u> service operate with a recommended **starting bank of 20 points** and promise to triple this bank over the course of 2011 MLS season.

The service provide between 3 and 6 tips, motivated by a brief synopsys, directly in inbox, 24 hours before kickoff, from each round of games. Back bets only, no laying and no exchange requirement.

The tips could be straight win bets, over/under total goals bets, asian handicap bets and occasional parlay.

Coverage of Major League Profits – complete MLS season, including MLS Cup Playoffs and final in november, occasional bets from US Open Cup and CONCACAF Champions League matches involving MLS teams.

Full results from March to May are available on the Major League Profits website.

As it is anticipated that it is likely that there may only be action once or twice a week, we will be going straight to a 12 week review for Major League Profits.

For Major League Profits review I will use 1 pt level stake per bet, as recommended by the service.

So how much will the subscriptions cost? Currently at the time of doing this posting it costs $\pounds 25.00$ per month and two discounted packages are also available for half a season the price is $\pounds 49.00$ and full season $\pounds 98.00$.

This review of Major League Profits will start from Monday 13th June.

Bookmaker -the odds are the average odds available from about 30 different bookmakers as listed by <u>betbrain.com</u> at the time of the email with selections.
