

### 1) **+£13.50**

PaddyPower free bet. Very simple stuff, and a little more than £13.50 profit risk-free.

### 2) **+£20.50**

Same as above, this time from BetClic. Nothing really to comment on, just following the recommendations from the vendor's email, which resulted in a bit more than  $\pm 20.50$  again risk-free.

### 3) **+£12**

This was a casino promo running at 888.com, which I mentioned in Week 1 post. Decided to go back to this one and did it twice. Although, it could be done every day I didn't want to overuse it and get banned out of the promotion. Not that much work to do, but it does take some time and effort, especially compared to the above offers. Wasn't very lucky there as I earned only about £12, but it's a long-term offer, and I think that overall profit will be worth the effort.

Overall **+£46** this week, a nice and easy profit.

**Running bank - £440.5 (plus £190.5)**
